Dear Mr. Grey:

On behalf of the Continuing Legal Education Department of the New York State Bar Association, I want to thank you for your participation in the "Insurance Issues in Personal Injury Cases for the Experienced Litigator" Seminar, which was recently presented in New York City and on Long Island. We are very grateful for your assistance with this seminar. It was especially generous of you to agree to speak at the presentation in two locations.

My office is pleased with the quality of the seminar and with the response it received. There were 118 preregistrants in attendance in New York City. In addition 9 registered on site. Most attendees gave the program a rating of "Good" or "Excellent." In general, there were few written comments. A few people expressed the wish that the program be expanded to two days, and a couple of attendees wrote that they would like to have had more time for questions and answers. A different attendee wrote this: "**excellent printed material.**" Someone else wrote this: "**Materials are very informative and comprehensive.**" One attendee wrote this: "**the materials, albeit not covering as many topics as I would like, were very good.**" Another registrant wrote this nice comment at the bottom of the evaluation sheet: "**The speakers were knowledgeable, spontaneous, and nice. Very enthusiastic coverage of what could be dull subject matter.**" One person wrote this by Mr. Grey's name: "**very admirable, calm, unflustered demeanor. . . .**" Another attorney wrote "**Excellent speaker—kept it interesting!**" by Mr. Avallone's name. One attendee wrote "**the program should be offered in the manner that J. Dachs made his presentation. . . .**" I enclose copies of the evaluation sheets for you. We do not automatically send these out to speakers unless requested but you may choose to do so. In addition, we will send you a typed summary of all comments and ratings as soon as it is available to me—probably in about one month.

There were 141 preregistrants on Long Island. In addition 26 registered on site. Sixteen who had preregistered did not attend. One person wrote this: "**very well orchestrated program.**" A different attendee wrote "**Gray's content was very important. . . .**" Someone else wrote "**Vasile and Avallone were excellent.**" Another attendee wrote "**Content great; presentation terrific**" by Mr. Avallone's name. Two people wrote "excellent" for Judge Brennan's presentation. One attorney wrote "**very well done**" about the course materials. One person wrote that the "**printed materials were excellent.**" Another said the printed materials "**were great.**"

As a token of our appreciation for your efforts on behalf of the seminar, I am pleased to a certificate expressing the Bar Association's appreciation. In addition, we enclose a complimentary pass to a New York State Bar Association seminar.
